



Bazooka for regaining insect biomass


1 head of cattle out on pasture can bring BACK 100 kg of insect biomass into our landscape

Survey of wild pastures in Germany: where do we stand?

Problems

Differing criteria, dynamic pasturing, etc.

Many pastures too small

Only few landscape elements

Only seasonal

Antihelminthics common

Rotation and paddocking

Additional mowing

Statical conservation (mowing) vs. dynamics of grazing

Habitat type 6510 (lowland hay meadow): lack of historical reference

"Prozessschutz" in Germany

More forest grazing needed

Standardised survey is needed for future strategies!
